They won't see other people and will part ways amicably at the end of the cruise where they will be free to see other people. There is to be no emotions or commitment being the twelve days. (This is a romance though, so you know something about this has to change, right?) The story goes on with amazing sex and the female and male leads gradually start to share more personal information with each other. I won't share the rest of the storyline with you because I would have to give away some secrets that it's best to find out as you read the story, but I will definitely mention that the book ends on a cliffhanger and that you will immediately
