This is my first original MMF and I picked it up because it was clearly stated there was action between the two male characters, and not just scenes where the female character was at the centre of everything. In that, the book delivered, but it was disappointing in a lot of other aspects.

First of all, there is no build up: the main characters fall in bed together a few hours after meeting. Even if you can buy the insta-attraction, going forward with the story, the only thing that connects them is sex, and it feels forced, not natural. There are a few passages where there's more attraction between the two male characters, even if it's their first same-sex experience (and really, where are the doubts, the questions about their sexuality? One of them has, at least, felt attraction towards other guys, but the other one hasn't, ever), than with the woman.

You could think that I'm judging the book too harshly, that I'm expecting too much from it, but even if you want to read it just for the sex scenes, I found those disappointing as well, mostly because sometimes you can't follow who is doing what to whom. Sometimes it felt like the author herself was confused about what was happening in the scene. And that is beside considering the unsafe sex and the fact that one of them has a twisted ankle, but he's all good while they twist around.

That said, the characters weren't flat and their backgrounds made for an interesting mash. They just needed to have time to build their connection, and not just sleep together.
