This is Book 3 in the author's Post-Apocalyptic Series ("The EMP"), as in ElectroMagnetic Pulse. I had only read 3-4 other "Post-EMP" series books but found these scary scenarios fascinating. Could an EMP occur (either nuclear-delivered or from another high-energy source aimed at destroying some or all of the United States' electronic devices) which would make the country totally unstable. In Book 3, you follow 3 storylines, and meet "preppers", random strangers who come to depend on each other, and some very violent people who will do anything for food and water. Book 3 is very good, but you must read Book 1 and 2 first to understand the dynamics and the characters. I feel that R. Westfield's stories are good, and the characters' ordeals are fairly realistic . (Although they would have come in contact with more people (dead or alive), and disabled cars would have filled the roads). Book shows very good character development. Several weeks after the EMP , marauding militias are "shooting to kill" and stealing anything they can find. It's definitely becoming survival of the fittest and smartest -- and luckiest.
