(which is never ending). Full Court Press was well written and packed a lot in for a Novella and I was completely in Decker and Avery's world.

Decker a Pro Basketball Player and Avery a Journalist first meet at the start of their respective professional careers. Decker making a play on Avery dropping his towel in the locker room and baring all, embarrassing her in front of her peers - Not a great first impression!

We next see these two 10 years later, Decker now a father, a divorcee, about to be inducted into the hall of fame, now retired from the sport and making his way into commentating. Avery a sports broadcaster with her own network show. Neither of our leads have forgotten their first encounter and forced to work together side by side for 3 weeks reminds Decker why he wanted Avery the first time, and reminds Avery why she too felt their connection but is determined to resist yet more heartbreak.

The story told through dual POV, takes us through the weeks of Decker and Avery working together, the push and pull of their attraction and the cat and mouse game they play. As both our leads learn more about each other and Decker learns of Avery's loss and guilt they spend a night of passion together which only makes them see now is not the right time. of course we get the HEA in the end; but Kennedy writes an great story along the way that sucks you right in. I enjoyed her writing style, it flows and is easy to read. She wrote the chemistry between Decker & Avery well, and the banter between the two main character balanced perfectly. I hope there are more sports romance in her catalogue for me to venture into.
