The second, The Lust Bastion, lives up to the book's title - it's lighthearted fun. The ending is a bit thrown together, but it tells a good story.

The third, which takes up half the book, is the worst of the three. Chris Tanglen is trying for a wacky Douglas Adams-style humor, and it ends up just feeling superfluous and random in the context of the story. Worse yet, the tone of the humor makes it hard for the reader to root for the protagonists. And then it has the technical problem within the romance construct of having the two meet and immediately fall in love. You have to be a damn good writer to hold a romance reader's interest when a story opens with that. So, it's a random hodgepodge of ADD "humor" with some sex thrown in. A hour wasted of my life. (But at least I get to vent on here)!
