He is sick of the mewling women and when he gets an earful from Oli, he offers her a deal. He wants to hand over control and he wants her to dominate him in the bedroom.

At first, I was worried that I'd find Lex unappealing but I didn't. He most definitely wasn't a doormat and the fireworks between the two were explosive and he didn't let his alpha-ness retreat without a fight. The banter and bickering was funny and I think CM Stunich did a great job, it was really different from her previous books and it worked.
