Several of the students embrace this philosophy and begin attending University, but Tyana is determined to return home to find her sister, Cyena.

Things get a little complicated when Tyana and Ayme, another elite student, are nearly run over while having lunch in town, and they realize that someone from the rebellion has found them. On top of that, Tyana meets Collin, a human guy who instills feelings in her she thought died with Ryker.
