I have used several Fodor guides in the past for trip planning, and have found them very thorough and useful. This one is no exception. It offers a very detailed review of the various districts on the island of Maui, and what to do in each area. Numerous detailed maps are included, as well as a large pull-out map in the back of the book. The use of various colored fonts makes for an easy reading experience, and a detailed index and table of contents makes it easy to navigate to the info you need. In spite of the amount of detail included, this is a fairly compact guide, so you won't mind hauling it around with you during your travels. The quality of the color pictures is good, though there are not a lot of pictures, mainly just on the section intro page. Of course, this keeps the weight and cost down, which is a good thing.
