As I have stated numerous times, I love vampire and shifter books. I will read almost anything in this genre, good and bad, to get my fix. The *Shifter's Haven* series started out as your typical werewolf trope with the bonding, mating and lovers against the world type of fare. Unfortunately, the series has stagnated with the premise and has not moved out of that trope into a more unique or creative arena.

In this installment, we finally get wild child Aaron's story. Aaron, you will remember from book two, is Stefan's adopted son and has been accepted into the Morgan family via his father's mating with Cody. He moves with his father to their ranch and that is where he runs into his own mate, Cary. (You will remember Cary as the werecat from book three whose abusive mate was killed by Kelan Morgan). Just coming out of a bad relationship, Cary doesn't want to be mated to anyone, let alone an Alpha in the making like Aaron. So their road to love is rocky. Add in some crazy homophobic townsfolk who want to kill all the gay werewolves in the area — that would mean the entire Morgan clan — and you have the set-up for the novel.

Normally this type of Romeo and Juliet, star-crossed lovers theme would have hit all my kinks hard, but as I said when reviewing book three and this still applies to book four: "I felt there should have been some growth and depth in the story, otherwise why read it if you are getting the same old, same old." There is nothing new and fresh in this installment. Yes, Cary and Aaron meet, fall in love and mate. Yes, the bad guys come after them. But where is the new twist to the plot? In a series, there should be growth in each installment. Yet, in *Aaron's Awakening* I am not seeing that. It seems like the same plot as in book one, book two...you get the idea.

However not everything in this novel is a disappointment. I did like a new character that was introduced named Gregory, one of the supernatural council members. He added some spice to the book and I suspect he will be getting his own installment very soon. Plus most of the Morgan brothers are back with their mates and they are always a good time.

Now before anyone gets the idea I dislike this series, I don't, and I am not trying to bash it in this review. I rated books one and two with 3.5 and 4 stars respectively and really enjoyed them. But I just figured by now the reader would be getting a little different take on the traditional werewolf trope. So, unfortunately, I cannot really recommend this book unless you are a die-hard werewolf fan.
