This book is a case of getting too much of what I wished for, and in the future I will take more care in choosing books based on their length. After reading several novella length books and feeling dissatisfied with the resulting lack of depth, I saw this very lengthy book for a very good price and decided to go for it. The blurb sounded like something I might enjoy even though it is a rather over done plot - traumatized but strong woman meets amazingly wonderful men, who just happen to discover she is their mate when rescuing her. Much of the book after that is trying to convince Abbey that Clay and Hunter are the real deal.... even if they do just happen to be wolf shifters.

Just over 600 pages to tell a story that would have been far more effectively told in half the space - I really should have known better. The problem is, it's a sweet little story with characters that I found interesting and deserving of an HEA. Unfortunately I had to force myself to finish it after multiple, whiplash inducing, changes in Abbey's feelings about the whole "mate of two hunky shifters" thing. It was absolutely ridiculous the number of times she would feel the 'complete happiness and love' Clay and Hunter felt for her through their 'mating bond' and in the next scene would worry about their sincerity. I wanted to smack her upside the head for the number of times she asked if they really wanted her, a baby with her, a life with her, etc. etc. This book needed a good culling of attitude U-turns, there were far too many of them!

Sadly, I would like to find out what happens to several of the characters from this story in future books, but I just don't think I can go through more excessive waffling and winging in order to satisfy my curiosity.

I should note that this is the only book I've read in this series and I think it stood alone fairly well, although reading them in order may be preferable for many readers.

That was just amazing, but I'm left wondering why Abbey was so special? I'm not complaining, but I am wondering.

All in all, if you love reading shape shifters, and M/F/M romance, you really need to check this series out. I love how it's a gentle romance; it shows men whose main concern is treating their woman right. Just a heads up, there is no males calling the females "mean words".
