We finally have the 10th installment in the IDWMA serial and it was most definitely worth the wait. The conclusion to the second season was intense and still left us with so many questions to be answered. Season Three cannot come soon enough.

Vanora is in the midst of a cyclone. The purge is taking her friends and almost all of Roman's vampires are fighting for their lives. Aeron and his minions are on a killing spree with one main goal - Aeron finally possessing Vanora. Armando is still caught between his master and his love.

At the end of Season Two, the reader is left with the feeling that nothing will ever be the same. Now that Vanora has lost Roman and everyone else is under attack, she has very few options. And, finally, she is starting to see the position that Armando is in. Her reaction shows her maturity and growing ability to deal with almost un-winnable situations.

While each installment has been a great read and Rhiannon always masters character development, I thought Betrayal stood out in this regard. Alisha, Armando and others have been a strong supporting cast. But, this time, I felt a further connection with the others. Sheila and Alexander showed strength in their friendship to Alisha and Vanora. And, their relationship was one of my favorite aspects of this story. Sheila is one tough mama.

It goes without saying that the return of Greg was a winner. He was entertaining in the prior episode but he played a much more major role here. It will be interesting to see where his story goes.

So we are finally at the tenth and final episode of season two and it's been a wild ride for sure! So much has happened in this past season and so much has changed. The whole serial has been a whirlwind of emotions and I think Betrayal really manages to encapsulate all of that.

Vanora's life keeps changing in front of her eyes and I don't envy her situation at all. She's had to deal with so much and she's been incredibly strong through all of it, even when it felt like she had no true choices. In some sense she has managed to adapt to the horror and while her beautiful innocent is finally stripped away completely she has become fiery in her refusal to give up. We also get some more insight on some notable characters that I really appreciated. We get to see how Alisha deals with her visions, we learn a bit more about Leto (who I am immensely curious about), Greg Brady has a past I didn't expect, and Carlotta has a surprising softness.

Aeron is really creepy in his almost desperate desire to claim Vanora and it's really interesting to see just how far he's willing to go. As you all know by now Armando is my favorite and it hurts my heart to see him struggle so hard to turn his back on Aeron, and even though I know gothic horror rarely has happy endings I really wish that for him and Vanora. Some people are redeemed in this one and others haven't fallen to their death or the ruin of others, and I was surprised to see just who fell into what category.

If you haven't picked up this episode yet, do it! In fact if you haven't tried out this serial I really urge you to give it a shot. It has all the moody atmosphere of a gothic novel but it's combined with a quick and gripping pace that makes it hard to stop reading.

Vanora has come so far since the beginning of the series. Not only has she grown from a young girl to an adult, but she has become such a tough chick. She was always strong. She had to be, but she is totally kick ass now. She doesn't let her fear control her. She knows that Armando is keeping secrets, and doesn't want to know what they are because she knows that it may mean the end for them. She doesn't let any of that stop her though. Instead of running away from all the danger, she rushes right towards it. There is no way to hide, so why prolong it right? I totally loved her in this one. She stood up for herself and took control. She embraces her situation and tries to do what she can instead of trying to avoid it. It's been amazing seeing the changes in her through this series.

We also see the strength in the other vampires. We see how loyal they are and how much they are willing to risk for themselves, Vanora, and her family. And we get to see first hand how terrifying Aeron is. Okay, so we have gotten a bit of it, but this is just insanity. He is the definition of evil! At the same time, there is that allure to him. You know he is pretty much the most dangerous being there is, but he is intriguing and magnetizing. Even characters that I wasn't sure about really surprised me in this. There were certain ones who stepped in to help, when it's the last thing that I expected. Everyone in this series is so well developed that even though essentially it's about Vanora, you really get a full story outside of her as well.

I don't know that I have ever read back to back novellas, or novels for that matter, that are so continually intense and heart racing. Even when things aren't in the full swing of the action, you still feel that tension throughout! I have felt like my heart might beat right out of my chest if I don't read faster to know what comes next.
