This is a collection of 13 Short stories, and as such it was really important to me that I'll review each one individually. however, the rating is done as a collective.

May Sage: this is a prequel to First Wolf, and is in the same tome as the other shifter stories by may. I really liked how Hannah and Sora were connecting.

Vivienne Savage: at the beginning, Javier was so annoying, it was hard to fully like him, but Yasmin was truly enchanting and their love story was fun to read.

KN Lee: At first, I couldn't follow Alice & Collin's story - it felt like it started from the middle. But, as I got to know them both, their love was fascinating to see. Not an immediate interest for me, but worth diving into. ended with a cliffhanger - be ready!

Emma Alisyn: This story of Murisa & her mate was so smart & funny, and it dealt with some serious issues of disability. absolutely loved it.

Sheri-Lynn Marean: Tirah & Saber's story was so intriguing, I couldn't stop reading it, it ended way too soon.

Nicole Marie: Ash's strong character is fascinating, which is why I didn't really liked where this story was going, Too "Stockholm syndrome" to my liking.

Erin Bedford: A princess trapped by a dragon in a tower, only to be saved by a dashing prince. sounds cliché - doesn't it? But it really wasn't. this was an awesome story. really.

Emma Nichols: The dragons myth in this story was really unique, and added an interesting touch to the shifting side of it. Peri was a real person - not all perfect and really annoying at times - but that just made her more relatable.

Eileen Cruz Coleman: sadly, this one pissed me off. Something in it just wasn't working for me. It felt forced and more like a writing exercise than a fully formed story.

Marilyn Peake: Rose is trying to get out of the rat race of New York, so she moves to Ireland. There, her life will change more than she knows. This story had good bones but there were gaps in it that felt forced. There were a lot of moments that needed clarification. Interesting story but needs patience.

Kerry Adrienne and Lia Davis: Owen & Nadia's story is a thrilling suspense where I was on the edge of my seat - worth reading only if you are ok with darker topics.

TG Ayer: This short intron to Solaris was a real treat. It had a lot of fun yet serious moments - which made for a really good read.

Cathrine Vale: Luna & Kane's story is a tale of strength and overcoming pain. I really liked how it all unfolded.

I've only read Vivienne Savage's contribution so far - Bewitching the Dragon.

Anyone who follows my reviews knows that I'll read anything she writes, and this is no exception. It also did not disappoint. I can't wait for the expanded version of this story when it comes out later.

I love the growth of Javier's character as the story progresses--from the beach bum to the motivated young shifter with a purpose. I also love what that purpose turned out to be. His character arc is very finely crafted, yet still leaves room for the expanded story to come.

I'll admit I was a bit confused by who Yasmin was at first. (Part of the 'problem' with ordering a book based solely on the author - I don't always read the blurbs.) Even with the clues as to who her parents were, it still took a moment to register it was River and Zac's daughter. But that confusion didn't detract from my enjoyment of her character. She is a fine example of a confident young woman who would naturally result from two of the most awesome parents anyone could hope to have. (River and Zac are, I think, my favorite characters.)

I do see room for much more story development, and like I said, I can't wait for the expanded story. While this isn't technically a cliffhanger ending, there are several threads that can be expanded, and I definitely want to see more from these characters!
