Some aspects good, other aspects disappointing or just frankly anatomically inaccurate.

**WARNING: FRANK LANGUAGE AND USAGE OF ANATOMICALLY CORRECT TERMS WILL BE DISCUSSED HERE, SO IF YOU HAVE A PROBLEM WITH THIS, I ADVISE YOU SKIP READING THIS REVIEW.**

I'm rather disappointed. Author Cassandra Dee's definition of light BDSM is a little different to mine. I do not consider dirty talk, spanking, anal play, or anal sex as light BDSM. It's all part of the usual usual on the spectrum of sex play. So I considered this a bait-and-switch situation. You don't promise light BDSM unless you're willing to write about it. And if you're writing about a very vanilla virgin, you don't start "out-of-the-box" because lots of writing need to happen to properly progress from sexually clueless to Whore of Babylon. (Please note that my personal understanding of the latter term is in terms of sexual prowess, not how Bible Fundamentalists insist to view it.)

Length: Long novella.

Character development: I am not convinced that a vanilla virgin like Carrie could go from untouchable to full-blown bedroom slut in less than twenty-four hours. Trust me, a young woman whose been emotionally and physically abused by her alcoholic parents would be VERY leery to allow sexual contact which suddenly blossoms to becoming so sexually liberated? Not in my professional experience. I'm all for seeing Big, Beautiful Women getting the credit they deserve, but considering how little money was being devoted to food, I'm not sure she would be such a BBW without jutting pelvic bones which would make sex uncomfortable for both parties. As for Mason, I found the treatment of his character a little more interesting. I still don't believe he truly is a dom (based on what was actually written), but his thought processes were intriguing. I have to hand it to Ms Dee to have him refer to Carrie as "the brunette" rather than by her online name or her real name (which he knew already). I like it that he was seriously objectifying her. My only objection is that a person so jaded as him should take longer to transition his view of her as an asset to an actual human being with feelings. But that would mean this novella would actually have to be a novel.

I still wonder if female writers really know what's going on inside the mind of guys other than Jeff Foxworthy's revelation of "I want me a beer and I wanna see somethin' nekkid!" From my interviewing of too many guys about these subjects, they aren't thinking in such crass language. Mason is written to demonstrate this far more than any other alpha male in other romance novel/ies yet. Even the far more rich

guys think more in the usual terms as “cock” and “dick” rather than “f\*\*kpole” and other of its ilk. There is an old expression that what you think is how you will talk. It’s difficult to divorce one’s own thoughts from one’s actual words, especially when really angry. That’s the way it is with guys. (Even they admit that.) So I don’t buy this sudden switch to being a decent guy because he cares. He would more likely do it to protect his asset, including beating Carrie’s dad to a pulp.

Emotional development: I almost felt empathetic to Carrie because of how horrible her parents were. As for Mason, I was surprised that I wasn’t so turned off by his crass behavior, vulgar vocabulary, or jaded thought processes. Am I becoming just as jaded as he? Or was I pleasantly surprised at Ms Dee’s efforts to be able to reveal the thought processes inside a guy’s mind.

Speed of action: Pretty decent without feeling rushed... EXCEPT towards the end. I know the writer was convinced that a time gap of two weeks was needed, but I still think there should have been a gearing down which was not done. If more felt like there were missing pages in my manuscript.

Predictability: Well, since we were guaranteed an HEA, of course that’s predictable. What wasn’t predictable was that we never saw the light BDSM we were promised.

Credibility issues:

- (1) Nicole would have been more scarred than how she was portrayed, despite her sister’s interference.
- (2) Why would Carrie have a laptop which she would leave at home? If her parents sold Nicole’s newly purchased clothes so quickly, they would have sold that laptop ages ago!
- (3) What I don’t understand is why Carrie didn’t leave the house and apply for guardianship of Nicole. (Oh... this would have blown open the abusive situation at home, and we would have lost a lot of plot complications if she had done that...)
- (4) I did not see any REAL dom/sub behavior which involves a lot of mind manipulation rather than slap-and-tickle. There is a complicated psychology involved when a dom begins the LONG process of shaping a vanilla virgin into a true sub. That’s why I’m very disappointed in what was promised by the author.
- (5) SPOILER ALERT!! You have been warned. I wrote the following letter to the author right after reading my ARC:

PLEASE PLEASE PLEASE MAKE THE FOLLOWING ANATOMICAL CORRECTION BEFORE THIS EBOOK IS RELEASED TO THE PUBLIC TO PREVENT YOU FROM BEING AN EMBARRASSMENT TO FEMALE KIND:

*Because fuck, the sight of my dick halfway up her vag is incredible. Those butt cheeks are giant and white, the moons spread to reveal that pink slit. Except it’s not a slit anymore. The above is an excellent example of researching on the backs of other writers without even consulting an anatomy book. This is an embarrassment to womenkind in general. (I do not want anyone to think that Ms Dee is in this category before any jumps all over me.) But I have read way too much steamy sex scenes in which the hymen is mentioned in the wrong location or that the cervix can actually be penetrated under the usual circumstances (not including right after childbirth or after injection with certain drugs meant to relax that muscular donut).

Now I will add that I have not seen what will be finally released yet, but this isn't the first letter I have sent to Ms Dee about glaring inaccuracies any good editor would have caught. I don't have much hope that she will change it because it will mean she would have to change a large chunk of that steamy sex scene.

Grammar and technical problems: Still having problems with some grammar, a lot of punctuation errors, and broken paragraphs. Obviously, no editor involved.

Would I buy this novella? No. Probably because I thought of a better treatment of this novella that would had been more riveting than what we have here. I wish Ms Cassandra Dee would slow down and spend more time on her stories to create a truly amazing novel (which I KNOW she can do) rather than bang a novel/la out one right after another.
