I'm a sucker for series fiction and in this third Red Carpet novel we get the best of Josh and Clarie (Hollywood Ever After), as well as Gunner and Jenny (Hollywood Holiday) as their relationships intertwine with the budding romance between Josh's sister, Helen, and Claire's brother, Joe.

Helen's admired Joe from afar for years. Now he's moved to LA and wants to make Helen the center of his world, yet one medical scare after another forces her to push Joe away.
