The first third to half of the book weighed on my patience and took me way too long to slough through, but I flew through the last half.

Lowry has great command of metaphor. The Fear (related to the protagonist, Lily, wearing iron or exposure to magic) was described in such a way that I immediately recognized it as a metaphor for anxiety and depression. I think Lily's strength in enduring the Fear was the author's way of working/writing through personal experience(s) with anxiety and depression.

The other well-executed metaphor is (view spoiler) Lowry was fantastic at pulling the reader into Lily's emotions through appealing to the readers' own feelings and experiences.
