For a MC this book has something that would take any biker lover by surprise...a virgin club member. At the beginning Link has been kept captive by another club with the hope of getting info from him to take down his Prez but Link is not alone in the dungeon and he will soon lose his virginity by taking another virgin. Jordyn was in pretty tough shape and with a knife being held to her throat Link is ordered to take her in front of their captor and tormentor. Bone was holding that knife and was throwing his old lady at Link trying to get her to infiltrate the Knights of Sins MC. Jordyn and Link form a special bond with Link wanting to take down whatever or whoever it was that had Jordyn living in fear and pain. Would Jordyn come clean before it was too late and would her betrayal to Link's club brothers prove too much for him to get over.

And what a story it is! Capture, torture, rape (not wanted by either of the two involved), a deadly deal, snitching, healing, love, and death. The emotions run high in this well written story that will not allow you to stop turning the pages until you reach the bitter end. Jordyn is the victim in every aspect of her life. From the age of seven until now. She's used as a pawn, used and abused and again used as a pawn, until she is forced to return to the Knights of Sin MC, but she has Link, and although she doesn't totally trust any of them at first, she sees the gentleness in Link and he in turn helps to heal her. But there is still much that she hasn't told him. She's lied, trying only to save her own life, but she also doesn't want anyone in this MC to be hurt. The Rangers want one person and they want him badly enough to use her to get him. Only her past coming back has her running. Now she has her past and her present on a collision course and she knows that with either of them, she will die. But she still can't put Link in danger, nor the men and women that are his family.

These characters are very well written and complex. Link is beautiful in that his heart is good, he loves his family and has helped many of the women in the club with his gentle words. But don't let that fool you because when his anger is in full gear, he is a stone cold killer. Jordyn has been abused almost her entire life. Raised by a father who didn't want her to begin with, thrown into a MC that she thought would protect her only to become abused by them as well, then used to gain information about another club, her back is against the wall and she feels as though she has no other option. Together, these two find a connection, physical at first, but feelings grow. But her lies have Link warring within himself. He wants her, but he will not put any woman above his family.

I so enjoyed this entire series and this book is no exception. I cannot recommend this series, this book, highly enough.
