Frustrated that her writing is ordinary, she picks up a gun instead of a pen and creates a whole new world of prose. Marty Pitchford is a married man caught in a world of mediocrity and melodrama. Confronted by his wife's extramarital adventures, Marty embarks on his own tantalizing escapades. When his daughter's safety falls into the wrong hands, Marty must make a decision of what he truly wants.

Their journeys take exciting, bizarre, and dangerous, if not criminal, turns. The roads home appear bleak, so they turn to each other to help bring them back. Four writers. Four methods.
