This year she has come out of the gate with a breathtaking, well written, well researched novel about love lost and redemption called Blood Legacy.

Trina Markham, 26, is going to school, working at a church turned nightclub called Avalon, and living in the home of her great grandmother in NYC Gramercy Park District. Born of Spanish heritage, Trina has tried to keep her grandmother's home resplendent in that period and tone. Trina's great-grandmother is the light of

her life, now living in an assisted living facility. Her family has always spurned her as being weird and eccentric. Trina has always adored her, remembering as a child, fights and uneasiness when the family was around. Trina is at work at the club; this is the night Trina's life will be forever changed.

Three Hundred year old vampire, Carlos Salazar pulls up to the club in his Jaguar, looking for a night's pastime. Tall, dark and exotic, he enters the club, finds a table in the rear and orders a drink. He is watching the mixture of humans and Goths who come to the club.

During the evening, he hears a scuffle with his preternatural hearing, and comes to a hallway where two young vampires are raping and feeding off a young human girl. Trina comes upon the scene and he tries to glamour her into a state of not seeing or remembering the melee, but she shrugs off his trance.

Carlos is intrigued by her ability to do this. An intense and thrilling vampire epic:

This is an incredibly detailed and fast-paced paranormal story that had me hooked from the first page and rushing through the story to see what came next.

Carlos was unwillingly turned three centuries ago, since which time he has fought determinedly to resist his vampiric dark side, and fight for justice no matter what it costs. Trina is an unknowing 'sensitive' who can see more of the vampire world than she understands... or wants to see. At its heart, this is a simple love story; yet underpinning that kernel of romance is a vast story of confusing attractions and history, which elements combine to make a high-tension suspense plot.

Carlos and Trina are inexplicably attracted to one other: the ancient vampire with incredible powers, and the innocent waitress with as yet undiscovered abilities. The story spans three hundred years, has some beautifully detailed insights to Spanish culture, touches on the Spanish Inquisition, and – above all – twists and turns in a way that every clue dropped throughout the story is a riddle to a surprising turn of events.

The story is richly detailed, deliciously violent without crossing into gratuitous, with excellent prose quality and vivid detail. Both the sex and romance are described in a tasteful way, with no indulgences permitted. This book also rids itself of vampire clichés, and highlights the somewhat unusual routines of a vampire.

The conclusion is not, in any way, as inevitable as you might expect in any romance story. Edge-of-the-seat suspense. Recommended.

Review:

This story starts with just enough interest and action to keep you engaged but make no mistake, this is a romance. The fact that it is filled with action in various places do not stop the main thrust from being Carlos' attraction to Trina. This is your usual entertaining story about love, romance and the problems that come with it. Carlos' was turned hundreds of years ago in a violent act and has been struggling with his humanity because he promised his first love that he would remain the decent person that he was before his life was changed forever.

This is a love story that spans hundreds of years and has several nice plot twists and peaks into the past that make you feel more a part of Carlos'. Trina the girl with seemingly no real direction is working as a waitress at an old church turned nightclub which plays a part in the beginning to let Carlos' know that Trina is more than she seems.

The story is engaging and even in the parts of introspection it stays interesting. There are a few surprises along the way which astute readers can see coming in a general sense but that does not take away from the entertainment value of this novel.

If I have any complaints it would be that the majority of the secondary characters are somewhat 2 dimensional (with a couple of notable exceptions). This small note does little to impede the enjoyment of the reader but you got the feeling there was going to be more to some of them that never really materialized. Blood Legacy combines romance, action and character development in a good mix that results in a very

satisfied feeling at the end. This is probably about 4.5 Stars (a bit more or less depending on the reader) but I consider it a highly recommended reading experience. The sexual level of this novel is probably quite a bit above YA but short of erotic, good passion and emotional involvement. This will feed your revenge junkie a bit and sooth your White Knight syndrome a bit also, got it all.
