I received the ebook as a giveaway through Goodreads. I made it through about 50 pages, and just couldn't keep going. I was hoping for something of a female Jason Bourne. Several things were so disappointing to me that I couldn't continue:

- 1) The book needs the attention of a good editor. I noticed several issues with verb agreement and punctuation that would make a grammar teach faint.
- 2) Sudden plot changes with no explanation or context. Some were so jarring that I thought I had skipped some pages. There just wasn't enough around these events to give any credibility.
- 3) Lack of emotional depth. (view spoiler)
- 4) No character development. Things went so fast, with so little description or discussion, that I felt no connection what so ever to the main character. As a result, I felt no desire to keep reading.
