This was a very good story. It's the first story I've read by this author and based on this I'll be trying more of her work in the future.

Carrie is an interior designer. She works and helps out her sister with her family but doesn't have much of a personal life herself. While at a beach, she meets Eric and Zeke. When Carrie exchanges a kiss to each for help with a bathing suit malfunction, she realizes she has more attraction to these 2 than any other man she's met before. Unfortunately they disappear before she can get their number.

Eric and Zeke have been friends since they were kids. They're best friends and now live together and have their own business making high end furniture. When they meet Carrie the first time they let it go but when they run in to her a second time, they decide to push things as both men are very attracted to Carrie.

FYI, this story is a 3-way soulmate storyline so be prepared for an insta-love situation (or dam close) as this trio feels the connection pretty quick and, while their meetings tend to be brief, they have impact. The trio unexpectedly runs in to each other a number of times and the flames burn bright between them each time they do. The flames actually burn so bright that Eric and Zeke end up admitting their bi-sexuality to each other (something they've both been desperately hiding in fear of chasing the other off) and become intimately involved with each other while both are still perusing Carrie. Fortunately, Carrie is attracted to both of them and thinks that Eric and Zeke being together is hot so she doesn't object at all.

Unfortunately, the trio has objections from the families of Eric and Zeke (Carrie's family is accepting if a bit unsure). Eric and Zeke have to deal with discrimination because of their new relationship with each other and adding Carrie in to the mix just makes the families freak out more. Things get difficult and there are some stumbles along the way, but Carrie, Eric and Zeke make the effort. They decide they want to be

together and that they'll stand strong together against obstacles (even if the ones against them are their families) and they start their HEA together.

I really enjoyed this book. I loved Carrie, Eric and Zeke and was happy with their story. My only issue with the book is that I wish there had been a little more development of the trio's relationship once things were a little more settled between them (but it wasn't a major issue).
