Ok, so you have read Shattered Innocence? Check....., You were just as gripped and left with a feeling of your heart bottoming out by the cliffhanger ending? Check....., Then You NEED to grab yourself a copy of Shattered Lives in order to continue this amazing story beautifully written by Alexis Noelle because there is really only 1 word to describe it: WOW! Before I even begin I can easily tell you this is a 5\*\*\*\*\*Star Novel just like is original counterpart making The Shattered Series one that is Outstanding which is quite a feat given the category it is within which has exploded in recent years since 50 Shades of Grey.

Jessie no longer works as an "escort" after the takedown of her previous employer with her testimony and the ultimate realization and knowledge that the love of her life Damon is in fact an undercover cop called Nicholas who had been working the case when they became involved. What she has always wanted to know is if he got close to her because of the case or if what they had was real? At the courthouse Damon, from now on will be referred to as Nicholas as he no longer needs that cover identity, gives her a letter for her to read when she is ready. Unfortunatley she decides to destory the letter in an attempt to forget him before reading it, not wanting to face the horrible truth it may have just all been about the case. Just after she destroys the letter she learns that Nicholas was on board a helicopter that goes down killing everyone on board. Knowing she will now never lean the truth and hit with the realization that her love for him was real for her, she spirals into a massive whirl of depression..... So now you are caught up and we can begin.....

So, at the beginning of Shattered Lives we find out that Nicholas is in fact ALIVE! He just had to fake his death in order to avoid a hit that was taken out on his life which would have put Jessie in danger if he had remained "alive". Hiding out in the shadows he watches Jessie with a very heavy heart because when all is said and done he DID love her, it wasn't just the case and we are granted the knowledge of reading the contents of just what he did write in the letter he gave her.....If only she had read it! Within the novel we are allowed to read it from both character's POV which is a brilliant way of allowing us to learn so many secrets hidden from us during Shattered Innocence and boy you will not be disappointed! Little did we realize there was a lot more going on behind the scenes than met the eye as we are given a front seat into Nicholas's mind and memories of his POV of the events between him and Jessie, how he tried to fight his attraction and stay on target for the case, how he couldn't help himself and the true extent of how he endangered not only his life

but also his career by continuing following his heart! We discover just how much he is willing to put on the line in order to be with her, allowing her to mourn "Damon" and then re-insert himself into her life as Nicholas.....Only he's not supposed to be, he should keep his distance, he should stay away.....No one can know he is alive, not even Jessie - but watching her, never being able to touch her again, never being able to tell her he loves her again..... Can he do it? Can he hold on and keep watching her break, feeling himself broken?.....

Apart they are both Shattered but Together maybe they can Finally be Whole Again.....

Jessie has gone through hell since the crash "ending" Nicholas's life. In her grief she has really let herself go, getting thinner and becoming almost a recluse even from her best friend Lo. Together they have made a life being teachers at a local school, but when they are at home the closeness they once share is almost none existent. We delve into the past a lot within the book and discover just what Lo went through and why her and Jessie are so close. After almost a year of grieving and mourning Lo decides it's time for Jessie to begin to move on and it is just as she begins to take this step that strange things begin to happen around her to remind her of Nicholas, of their relationship making her think that she is going almost crazy. But in a way it gives her a sense of peace, a connection to the man she lost, the letter she destroyed, his final words to her.....that is until she realises that he is actually alive. This realization and their meeting kicks off a series of unforeseen events that will create a whole world of trouble for them both.

There is a scene near the end that for some readers may be too much as it contains graphic sexual abuse and violence. But the way it is written ensures that the subject is handled in a sensitive way in context to the subject plot surrounding it. The plot itself is brilliant and an excellent continuation from Shattered Innocence, no so much that it is just rinse and repeat, it is a brand new plot but links back to the previous novel. With so many twists and turns, secrets revealed, the past uncovered and so many questions answered it simply is excellent, a total thrill and will have you hooked in no time at all!
