What I liked:

- The friends to lovers theme was great.

Texas Tangle is a wild erotic ride and will take the reader on an emotional journey that they won't soon forget as three wounded characters learn to love and come together as one. Why I read: I wanted to try a book by the new publisher, Carina Press, and this just caught my eye. (Ok, so it was the TWO dudes and just one girl on the cover...who could resist?)

Favorite Quote: "What sane woman would object to having two hot guys buck-ass nekkid on each side of her?"

Dillon Barnett comes from a very close knit Texan family. Even his foster-brother Brett has always felt at home. Rescued from an extremely abusive father as a child, Brett has grown up as a close brother to Dillon. They have definitely had their bumps along the way though. In high school, they both lusted after the same girl, Nikki Kimball, and although Brett shared a night of kissing with her, as adults, Dillon is the one to make a move towards romance.

Nikki suffered years of a verbally abusive marriage, and still suffers from verbally abusive parents. Now divorced, she took Phil, her brother in, in hopes that he can move past his criminal youth and make a life for himself. Nikki's truck breaks down and Dillon just happens upon her. Her night is about to go from possibly a little action with Dillon to catastrophe. Nikki comes home to find herself robbed of all possessions, and Phil nowhere to be found. He also takes off with her money, leaving Nikki with nothing. Dillon offers her a place to stay at his house, and they both want to explore the physical side of their lust.

It doesn't get past Brett that his foster-brother Dillon and best friend Nikki definitely have something going on, and Brett feels left out. Brett feels like he owes Dillon his life for practically saving him from his abusive father, so he would never do anything to break apart the special thing happening between them. But he can't help but wonder what it would have been like if he was the one who had come across Nikki in her broken down truck. Soon, though, he may get a taste of what it is to love this woman, even if he has to share.

I have a little rule when it comes to a ménage – brothers should not see each other with hard-ons. Texas Tangle features two foster brothers, not related by blood in any way, so this passes the test for me. I also say you can't just throw three people together and have some naekey time and expect the reader to fall for it. Leah Braemel really works in the back story, giving us Dillon and Brett, who are very close, yet have young adult drama that have driven them so far apart in the past. Nikki knows them both growing up, and now that her drama has ended with her ex-husband, she is at the perfect spot in her life for something new.

At the end, I believed in this trio. I didn't love that many accepted a threesome so easily. His mother and others were rooting for the three of them to get together. It all seemed a bit too easy on the family end. However, Nikki, along with Dillon and Brett don't take the choice easily. They really spend so much of the book analyzing and really making sure this is the right choice for all of them and consequently, their relationship comes across very mature. Although I think you do have to give a bit over to the fantasy side. I mean – two really hot dudes that worship just this one girl? But hey, isn't that why we read these books?

Best of all, their sex scenes are smokin'. Brett doesn't make an appearance in the bedroom until after the halfway mark, and by the time he shows up, I was READY. Brett is a quiet man, but such a dirty, dirty boy. Leah Braemel gives us plenty of hot scenes and I really enjoyed them.

Right from the first page Texas Tangle by Leah Braemel draws you in, It's a pantie squealing read for sure and if it had had another 100 pages of Dillon, Brett and Nikki I would have been a happy girl.

With just three main characters and a handful of secondary characters none of which leave you confused with "who is that again...who said what?" Just the right amount of protagonists to build an erotic tale that has both story and substance too.

Nikki is a girl you can like, I did, even if there were times she irritated me slightly when she was all angst ridden about which man to choose, but she is just a sweet country girl, lonely and is suddenly drawn into double attraction from Dillon and step brother Brett.

It's hard to write a review for a book that just doesn't do it for you and you can't pinpoint why? I didn't hate it, but didn't love it. If I had to accurately describe my feelings...I tolerated it.

I liked the cover and the premise sounded promising. I should have felt sorry for the heroine, but I didn't. I should have swooned at manly men Dillon and Brett, but I didn't. Sometimes you just don't make the connection. Doesn't mean it won't work for you. Lots of people liked Texas Tangle so you may too. After all we all can't like the same food, men or books. Nikki Kimball has definitely been dealt a raw deal. She's newly divorced trying to make a go of running a horse breeding ranch. So now years later, just when it seems like Nikki's life can't get any worse, it's like she's been gifted with these two hunky guys served up to her on a silver platter and now she's supposed to choose between them...or not.

I found it interesting that after almost ruining the brother bond between Dillon and Brett when they were in

high school when Brett and Nikki shared a kiss - now they're just going to let bye-gones be bye-gones like nothing happened and share her in and out of bed? When I read a menage book, I usually look for a happy ending for all three persons involved, not where a main couple includes a third party that in the end gets kicked out of the picture. Texas Tangle falls into the first category and that alone is enough to make me happy.

Here we meet Nikki. Divorced from an unfaithful husband and saddled with a deadbeat of a brother, found herself involved with her next door neighbor, Dillon and his foster brother Brett.

Unlike most menage books, you get a pair of men here who did not even think at the very beginning of sharing. You get to experience their own individual thoughts, complete with their own insecurities and jealousies. Add to that Nikki's own issues, and you have three people trying to find their path as they try to decipher their feelings for each other and how can they be happy without hurting the other.

I find the presentation of each character's concerns realistically portrayed, fitting to their own upbringing and values. Nikki has to believe that she is worthy to be loved, Dillon has to learn that generosity is part of loving and Brett has to accept that he is no outsider as they weave a tangled relationship that will in the end dare them to find an unconventional solution for their love for each other.

If you like menage books, and you like hot, sexy writing, coupled with some realistic issues in such type of relationships, then you should get a copy of Texas Tangle.
