The title of this book is misleading and unfortunate. Secret baby implies that this is a formulaic book and that the heroine has hidden the hero's baby from him and he finds out about it in the first part of the book and the rest of the book is the fallout and how they get back together and become a happy family. Not the case here. The baby is his from a one night stand and the hero has had custody for 8 months before the story starts. This is a book about the hero falling in love with his daughter's doctor. It covers several serious themes such as addiction, childhood transplants, and immigrant mores clashing with more open American culture.

The characterization was well done. You could see the hero dealing with his recovery from addiction and the heroine learning to step beyond the rigid expectations of her family. I really liked the hero and how all in he was for the heroine and for his daughter. The Rock Star's Secret Baby is more than just a really good story. I learned so many things just by reading this book. We start with Cadell Glynn, the prodigy guitarist for Killer Valentine. Cadell is a heroin addict who quits cold turkey when he suddenly finds himself with a two-year-old daughter, Emily, who is dying from liver failure. Fearful of losing his place in the band if they find out about his daughter, he keeps her a secret.

Dr. Andy Kumar is Emily's doctor, a pediatric surgeon specializing in liver transplants. Dr. Andy is of

Indian descent raised by very traditional parents. They had arranged a marriage for Andy with a suitable man that she had only met twice. Away from her position as a surgeon, Andy was very meek, submitting to her parents and to her place in her society where women were not valued as highly as men.

Reading this story, I learned much about liver transplants, organ donations, and pediatric liver disease; about heroin addiction; but mostly, Blair gave me an insight into Hindu and Indian beliefs and traditions. Cadell has fallen in love with Andy, but he doesn't want to tear her away from her family and friends and he knows she is supposed to marry a man she doesn't even know. At the same time, Andy is fighting an attraction to Cadell, plus feeling the stress of her family's expectations of her place in society.

Cadell turned out to be the most gentle, thoughtful person that I've found in this series. I think this might be my favorite book because there were so many levels, so much detail, and so informative while telling a sweet story.
