Alexander is a vampire who spends his nights preventing crimes from taking place. On one such night, he makes it there a little late resulting in two deaths, and one survivor, a young girl, Zoe. Immediately afterward he leaves her but can't stop worrying about her. So he decides to meet her in her dream the next night(?). They communicate in this way for the next 6 years. Zoe writes about her dreams that include Alexander in her journal, wishing that he was real. Alexander falls in love with her and at the end of these 6 years, decides to reveal the truth about him but upon reaching Zoe, he hears happy and yet sad news, causing him to leave her for the next 5 years.

In the present time, 5 years later, Zoe finds her journals and reads them over. These are the flashbacks that let us know more about their 6 years meeting together in her dreams. This leads to a sweet ending.

I gave this story a 4.5 because it could have used a little more of the present time and less of the flashbacks. I would have loved an even longer version of it. It's very nicely written. I did get a little distracted by all the italicizing at the end. The journal entries are shown in italics and so is the rest of the story after that. Overall, loved it. It was sweet
