REVIEW: 4.25 stars-- GLORIOUS SINNER is instalment 4.5 in Sherilee Gray's contemporary, adult LAWLESS KINGS erotic, romantic suspense series. This is mobster Thomas Mendoza, and exotic dancer Stephanie Gable's story line. GLORIOUS SINNER can be read as a stand alone without any difficulty. Any important information from the previous story lines is revealed where necessary. Thomas and Stephanie first appeared in Ruthless Protector Book #4

NOTE: The story line contains scenes of graphic violence, and may not be suitable for all readers.

Told from dual first person perspectives (Thomas and Stephanie) using present day and memories from the past GLORIOUS SINNER follows Stephanie Gable as she must come to terms with the demons from her past. Married to an abusive man Stephanie knows should anything happen, long time family friend Thomas Mendoza is only a call away, a call that would eventually save her life. Seven years earlier, Stephanie caught a glimpse of her potential future when her then boyfriend Ryan started showing signs of abusive behavior; fast forward six years and our heroine is in for the fight of her life when Ryan leaves Stephanie alone to die, forgetting about her connection to local mobster Thomas Mendoza. With all potential threats against her life no longer in the picture, Stephanie returns to exotic dancing until the fateful night the mysterious messages and gifts start appearing at her door. Enter Thomas Mendoza, the man who has loved our heroine for a number of years but a man who believes he isn't worthy of Stephanie's love. What ensues is the building romance between Thomas and Stephanie, and the potential fall-out as Ryan returns to finish the job.

GLORIOUS SINNER is a story of power and abuse; friendship and love; second chances and a happily ever after. Sherilee Gray pulls the reader into an intense, gritty and emotional story line as one woman struggles

to move on from her past, and one man battles his attraction to a woman who isn't ready to move on with her life. This picks up on and goes more into detail on some obvious tension that we saw between a stripper at Stilettos and Tomas Mendoza back in a previous book. We get some of their background and a conclusion to their romance. Tomas is the bad boy - which is putting it mildly. In this universe, he is the crime boss who gets things done and doesn't care how. But his hard and fast rule is that he doesn't hurt women. Stephanie Gable has been hurt plenty, by her husband Ryan. She knew Tomas back when she was a young kid and in puppy love with him, but he knew she deserved someone better so he stayed away, but swore to protect her if she ever asked. She didn't ask until she lay near death from the most recent beating and Tomas realized how much she meant to him. But he wanted to make sure SHE had the control in whatever relationship they had, since she'd had so little in her marriage. But Steph has walls that are miles thick and Tomas just can't seem to break through them. But when her husband shows up again, she runs to Tomas, giving him hope. He will do anything to protect her this time and to show her that love is worth it when it's done right.

This kind of works as a standalone, since it's only set in the universe and the characters from the King Agency are present, but not really integral to this story (at least not their backgrounds). And this is a nice little slice out of that universe. I admit the interaction between Tomas and Steph back in the previous story intrigued me and I wanted to know more. This delivered. Tomas, with his willingness to do anything for the woman he loved, was pretty awesome hero material. Not that he's a hero in any other way...he's still a crime boss. But Steph could consider herself one lucky bitch with a guy so dedicated to her happiness. He's patient, he's loyal and he's absolutely in love with her. And no matter how much baggage she has or how thick those walls, he refuses to give up on her. And on top of that, they have some pretty damn sexy scenes together.

So why only 3 stars? First and foremost, the grammar and typo errors in this book drove me up the wall. I

can look past the first one or two, but when they start adding up, I start going apeshit crazy. Just how I roll. Secondly, and this is more my preference, I wanted some elaboration or further addressing of Tomas's job. We only ever get the explanation that he's a crime boss, he sits on his laptop quite a bit doing God-only-knows-what and that people live in absolute fear of his anger. Ryan at one point indicates that he was a drug-dealer and a pimp. But we never really find out WHAT he did that was so bad...assuming maybe he dealt in drugs, guns, prostitutes and murder. I mean, how the hell else does he have that much money? Supposedly, he gave up quite a few of these ventures once he realized he was in love with Steph, but this is a throwaway line with no detail or explanation given. He's still a crime boss, so he must still be doing some of them I guess. Without the author's going into detail, I'm left believing the worst of this hero...what kind of awful stuff has he done in his past and why doesn't the author have him dealing with that. If he's done the worst that I'm imagining and he's feeling no guilt about it (other than maybe feeling like it would hurt the heroine), then he's a sociopath, and this is not a good trait for a hero. It's hard to make the claim that your "criminal hero" is reformed when you don't know what he did in the first place and you give no proof that he's any better now. I'm given to believe that if he's still wealthy and still a crime boss that he's still having gamblers who can't pay back their debts, beaten or murdered or something, despite his claims to reform. So having that swimming in the back of my head while I'm reading about this loyal and loving hero kinda dims the appeal of him.

Glorious Sinner has a Ruthless King feel to the narrative, with the crime lord having a softer side where the woman in his life is concerned while maintaining a callous exterior to everyone else.

Stephanie and Tomas first meet when Stephanie is 16 and Tomas is working construction for her father. Their age difference and Tomas's background prevent Tomas from admitting to reciprocating Stephanie's feelings. Leading Stephanie into a relationship with a popular boy in her high school; while on the surface their relationship appears perfect there is a lot of ugliness waiting to break through the surface. Over the years the hideous overtakes any perfect leaving Stephanie a shell of her former self. The only things that keep Stephanie surviving are the knowledge Tomas is there in the background if she were brave enough to reach out to him and dancing.

Only when Stephanie is broken and bloody does she reach out to Tomas for help. Unfortunately, this only adds to Stephanie's belief that Tomas views her as fragile and broken. Slowly piecing the broken parts of her life back together, Stephanie only survives by being virtually numb but when her sociopathic husband returns to terrorize Stephanie, she has to confront her fears and the underlying emotions she has always held for Tomas.

I loved how protective Tomas was of Stephanie, kind, and patient in all areas. A complete contrast to his everyday crime lord persona and terrifying reputation. His determination to be the man Stephanie deserved almost cost him the thing he coveted the most. Giving this second-chance to be with Stephanie ensures Tomas will do anything to make it happen.

The chemistry between the pair is combustible but Tomas guarantees a slow-burn in order to pave the way for a lasting relationship beyond the physical.

Through Tomas's belief in Stephanie and the protection he offers, Stephanie is able to resurrect the pieces of herself she thought were long dead and buried. I loved watching Stephanie blossom and become the woman she was always supposed to be via her connection to Tomas.

Whether it's sexual, emotional or situational, the best kind of tension is between characters when they're drowning in unresolved feelings and unfulfilled needs. Sherilee Gray's fifth book in the Lawless Kings series, Glorious Sinner, has them all. It's a sexy, emotional roller coaster that's worth the price of admission.

The Lawless Kings series follows the lives of five men who grew up together (two brothers, two friends and an outlier who's more of an ally than friend). Tomas Mendoza is the outlier — a ruthless crime boss who never hesitates to exploit a person or situation to get what he wants. And whereas the rest of the guys in the series banded together to form The King Agency, Tomas focused on building his own empire.

Until the woman he's loved from afar since they were teenagers needs him. Then everything changes. And if he was dangerous before, he's apocalyptic now.

Years later, Tomas has remained on the fringe of Stephanie Gable's life. She married an abusive man, hiding the horror of her situation until one attack nearly killed her, and she had to call on Tomas ... a man who struck fear in the hearts of most who came across him. And boy did book five in the *Lawless Kings* series deliver. You don't have to have read the books that came before *Glorious Sinner* but it does give you an insight into this couple before we get up close and personal with them in it.

"You can do better... So much better."

This is a couple that goes back years, but Steph's age initially, and then her dead-beat husband keep her and Tomas apart. But he has always been there for her, and generally in her darkest hours.

"Everything I've done for you I'd do again in a heartbeat. I don't expect, I don't want anything in return... You're worth everything I've done and so much more."

Twelve months on from him removing said husband from her life, Tomas can no longer hide or deny his feelings for Stephanie, and although it's been a long road to getting her confidence and sense of self back, Steph is starting to think along the same lines... that is until it looks like her past has come back to haunt her.

"I've wanted you since the first day I saw you... That never changed, not in all these years."

Being forced to keep close quarters with each other for her protection, as you would expect does nothing to mute the sexual chemistry between them, and it doesn't take long for both of them to decide that they aren't hiding from it anymore either. But Steph is still a little gun-shy when it comes to moving things into the bedroom due to lack of experience, and fears that Tomas will only ever see her as the broken girl he has rescued on more than one occasion, rather than the woman who wants him more than her next breath.
