For my Goodreads rating I have to go with 3.5 stars.

I liked this book and some areas it was more than like but oddly enough there was an area of dislike too. Let's get the worst out of the way, Now I have read many, many menage books, kink books, sexual pet acting books.... see how diverse my reading can be, well in the case of the MM/FF and FF in this book I absolutely didn't feel it at all.
