Let me start off my review by saying that I usually prefer ménage romances that are about m/f/m relationships rather than f/m/f, but I gave this book a shot after reading positive reviews on Amazon and Goodreads. Lisa's Gift has an interesting premise, but the choppy writing and over usage of internal dialogue are detractors to the story. This was one of those books where I wanted to scream out loud in frustration at the characters to actually just have a conversation with one another and express their feelings instead of them constantly internally analyzing everything to death. Also, I like a good BDSM erotic novel and don't mind a sexy alpha/Dom male in the least, but I found myself rolling my eyes a few times at the "Milord" stuff in this story because it just seemed a tad over the top to me and not quite believable for the characters. I figured out the plot and "gift" from pretty much the beginning of the story, so no real surprises with the ending. There's a nice HEA and like some other readers whose reviews I've read, I did shed a few tears. Overall, it's a pretty good f/m/f ménage BDSM erotic romance with heart.
