Authors love to write series because it lets them get more return on the investment of time in creating characters and a universe. Many readers love them because they feel comfortable in that universe and view the additional books as a continuation of their exploration of that literary universe.

The downside is that sometimes authors become too formulaic in the later books. When you read them, you

know what is going to happen before you're 20 pages in. They stop holding your attention. They become stale and trite.
