He was asked by his brother Dax to assist the Klein pack in Las Vegas with their system security. Little did he knew that his carefree life will end as soon as he will meet his mate.

Layla was in charge with the VIPs in her family hotel, loved to work, dress up and had no intention to find a mate.

Everett and Layla met at her family pack run and as soon as they locked eyes they knew they are destined to be together.

Few hours later they were married (by Elvis) and mated.

Their new found love and life as couple was threatened by a VIP client who didn't take Layla rejection very well.

After family interference, wedding preparations and getting shot at Layla and Everett get their HEA.

This is the second book in the Pacific Northwest Cougars and was more entertaining than the first one due to the family interference.

I liked Everett and Layla's attitude towards the mating but I was not a fan of the insta-love, lust and "I love you" that happened in a span of less than 12 hours.

Again the first 60 pages of the book were spent on both characters life and daily activities which took out from the couple build and connection. I would have wanted to see a bit more of Everett and Layla together prior to being mated.

The things slowed down a lot during the wedding preparation and the few incidents (sent flowers and heart) didn't manage to build enough momentum for the shooting. Toward the end the book felt rushed and the Epilogue kept simple and short.

I missed the character build, some attention to the secondary characters and maybe hints for the following books.

Because I do not have any connection with any characters I have no expectations for the third book or curiosity to read more.

I am sure the book will appeal to most of the shifter story readers but for me was just there. So if you are looking for a short insta-lust, insta-love shifter romance a bit family drama this book should satisfy your reader's needs.

Layla and Everett's romance is a bit different from the other couples in both the Pacific Northwest Werebears or this PNW Cougars series. This smokin' hot couple are both shifters. Both know and understand that they have a fated mate "out there" somewhere – they are simply waiting to find them. They might "know" what is fated for them, but in reality when they meet they get a completely new understanding of the term...mate.

Layla is a very dedicated worker at her family's hotel on the Las Vegas strip. Their hotel is the hottest and coolest spot on the strip and she will continue to keep it right at the top. She rarely gives herself a break, aside from fantastic shoes, outfits and the occasional massage. Layla is driven. She is also waiting for her mate, and if she pushes herself at work in order to make the time pass and keep her mind off of the waiting – that's her secret to hold.

Unfortunately, Layla has a stalker in the form of a one date wonder who believes his role as the son of the local mob boss gives him the right to take what he wants. Between phone calls, flowers and a never ending monologue of really bad pickup lines, this jerk does not understand the meaning of NO.

Everett is a geek. And proud of it. He has no interest in the family vineyards, his love is computers and gaming. When not doing one, he's most likely doing the other. Finally giving into his big brother Dax's Alpha command that he head to Vegas and help out the Klein pack with their hotel security, Everett reluctantly heads to the desert. If he'd had any idea of who waited there for him, he might have moved a lot faster.

While on a midnight Pack run with the Klein pack, Everett and Layla finally meet – and that meeting is explosive. Each instantly recognizing their mate without question. Without one mate being human, and needing to ease into the animal spirit part of their life together, this couple moves quickly to take their mate status to bonded in minutes.

While Layla and Everett become accustomed to finding each other – Layla's stalker turns up the heat.

Cougar's Luck is a more powerful or perhaps more intense story. And I believe that is because here are two full shifters, they have known their entire lives about their animal spirit's existence and known that there is a fate decreed mate in the world who will match them completely. Their physical bonding happens so much faster because frankly there is no human to have to explain what a shifter is or what mate bonding involves. Also the fact that the reader is aware of Layla's stalker early on in the story also ramps up the intenseness of this story.

I don't give away spoilers – but if you have read any of the previous novels you will know Dax and Everett's mom, Lilibeth. So wait for it. That's all I'm gonna say. *wink*

Once again, Ms North drew me into her shifter's lives and delivered an excellent story for them. Now I simply have to wait for the next story. If you enjoy Paranormal Romance, shifters specifically, then you will love Cougar's Luck.

This is another great addition to the Pacific Northwest Cougars series, a spin-off of the PNW Bears series. The books can stand alone and all have HEAs, but they flow from one to the next and involve the members of two families. So, they are best when read from the beginning.

Everett Hayes is a younger brother of Dax (book one), is a twin and a cougar shifter. He is also a computer whiz and has been asked to test the new security system of a Las Vegas cougar family, owners of the Platinum Hotel and Casino. He's invited to a run at the family compound and while out in the desert, his cougar smells his mate.

Layla Klein, the youngest female in her family, is in charge of the hotel's club, which she has made into the best in Vegas. Driven to work long hours, she arrives at her family's run late, but soon catches an enticing scent on the wind. Racing toward its origin she sees golden eyes in the darkness running straight toward her. Their cougars immediately recognize their mates and their humans soon follow, leading to a quick agreement that they belong together, details to be worked out later. But in the midst of their bliss, a stalker edges up his pursuit of the woman who spurned him, escalating toward violence. And leaving Everett scrambling to protect the mate he just found.

I have read 3 books so far in the Rochon Bears series and this and the previous book in this series, and the author is a good one who writes good stories, especially when it can be difficult to do a good job writing shorter books. She does that very well. The stories and characters are unique and sweet and fun.

My issues with this book -

1. Too many typos and structural issues, like with missing quotation marks and using "pact" once instead of "pack". There were too many issues for a published book.
2. Knowing that they will likely have mates somewhere, having sex with anyone before they find their mate is cheating. It doesn't make sense that the shifters will have sex with random people when they will likely end up mated. Why has a human not said "Wait, you knew you were going to be mated to someone but had sex with different people anyway?" It is mentioned that it's not fair to a human get involved with a human because they can't stay with them, but I haven't seen it mentioned where someone says it's not fair to the mates.
3. Some of the wording and dialogue feels wrong, like it's how people really talk. It makes it awkward to read.

Overall, I liked it, but there's room for improvement.
