I had always avoided L'Amour in favour of J T Edson. This is my first L'Amour. The short stories are quite good. especially "The War Party" and "The Law of the Desert". In fact "The Law of the Desert" is reminiscent of Rudyard Kipling's poem "The Ballad of the East and West".

The plots are a bit stereotypical. A lone gun man enters a community of cow boys, Ranchers and sharp-shooters. A widow or young girl struggles to run or retain her Ranch while a villain attempts to ruin her. The hero rushes to her aid, foils the villain with his fancy gunman ship and settles down with the lady. L'Amour explores this theme in so many ways. Though stereotyped the telling of these stories makes them interesting.
