However fun it was though, the story was just not very believable to the point of being silly. There were good scenes but it was as if they belonged in a different story.

I did find some amusement about the fact that the exchange took place on Rovertia. Would have been truly funny if a future h turned out to be half Nerakian. Of course, that leads to some questions since in the last book of THAT series, the US was well aware of life "out there" and had a working relationship with Nerak.
