What a storyline! The author's imagination and her talent as a storyteller is off the charts, i can't recommend this book highly enough! This story started off interesting and ended well (and nicely hot) but I felt that the middle wasn't well traversed.

Sage is a lawyer that works cases with supernaturals, often against them. She harbours resentment for fae because her father knocked up her mother and then left. She is attracted to a persistent fae who wants to be her next client and conflicted by the attraction she feels.

Tom is a fae who has made a life for himself in the human world. His greatest joy is his daughter, so he can't understand why his girlfriend has taken her and left. He appeals to a lawyer for help, and finds himself wanting the lawyer as well.

The attraction is fairly immediate and the two dance around each other. Adding in the daughter and a greedy girlfriend helps make the story more layered. I just didn't enjoy the jump in relationship. Sage resists Tom, then suddenly proclaims how she has been prejudiced against fae because of her father and is absolutely attracted to him. There was no good connection between the two so I felt that was a poor jump in story. Had this been executed better I would have liked the story much more.
