Although this is part of the Amish Protectors series, it can easily be read as a standalone. Hannah is a bit stubborn, but that only adds to the danger element of this suspense. Romance takes a backseat, as danger seems to be everywhere, amping up the pace until the surprise reveal. This is not your typical Amish-themed tale.

After learning that her mother was murdered and her sisters are missing, Hannah Miller sets out to find them. Apparently, someone believes Hannah knows more than she does about her family's whereabouts, which puts her in the crosshairs of danger. Despite her reluctance to get close to another man, Hannah has little

choice but to rely on Lucas Grant, a former English cop who is planning to join the Amish faith. Lucas thought he left law enforcement in the past, but he discovers that he may have a connection to those determined to prevent Hannah from finding out the truth.
