Can a fake relationship, built on lies, turn into the real thing?

A fast paced contemporary romance of a would be lawyer and a jaded billionaire. I have read quite a lot of this authors work and know she can write a warm, emotion filled and engaging romance. Whilst I haven't read any of the "Dirty" series of books (this is a stand alone so you don't need to have done so) I read a chapter reveal and was very intrigued to read this story of Graham and Bellamy. Whilst this isn't my favourite Amelia Wilde story, I did still enjoy it.

Graham is the brand new president's troublesome younger brother, during a staged media photo opportunity he meets Bellamy. Unfortunately the papers decide this by the book law graduate is a woman of ill repute and so ensues a series of attempts to shake the media of their tales. This includes a fake relationship and, when that doesn't work, a fake engagement. At least things start out as fake.....

I quite liked Graham until he met Bellamy, at which point he turned into quite an arrogant and unpleasant a\$\$\$. For most of the story he was pretty pleasant and likeable, though he did occasionally irritate me or puzzle me with his cold attitude. Bellamy is a really strong character though at first I felt she was selling out her principles. However given how devastating the media attention proved to be towards her fledgling law career, I can sort of understand her desperate attempts to salvage her future.

I was a little puzzled by the whole media hype, it seemed far fetched, but it is explained at the end of the story and was sort of obvious when it was. I did struggle to believe in the connection between Bellamy and Graham, they seemed to go from barely tolerating each other to being madly in love, with no interactions to

show how or why. This is why the book didn't rate more highly for me, other than this the plot and writing is very good.

This took me a couple of hours to read, and with the busy plot I wasn't tempted to skim read parts of it. It is fairly steamy at times, though I wouldn't say there was too much. It fitted in well and seemed a natural part of the story. I'd recommend this to any fan of the author or to anyone looking for a well written, low on angst read to fill a couple of hours.

Graham Blackpool is a billionaire playboy. He's also the younger brother of the President of the United States. And their relationship is often a contentious one.

Bellamy Leighton is a coffee barista only to pay the bills for her law school tuition. She's short on sleep and has a singleminded focus towards her goals. And she's big on honesty and truth.

A chance meeting at the coffee shop where she works brings Bellamy into Graham's path and the ever-present press twists the reality of their meeting into something much darker and more nefarious. And Graham's presidential brother *requests* a favor from both of them, which will require Graham to leave behind his playboy ways and Bellamy to depart from that honesty she so dearly values. The farce begins.

But it's not all fake. The web becomes increasingly more tangled, and so do Graham and Bellamy's feelings. Will Graham's desire to please his family and Belle's drive to be truthful cause an irreparable schism between the two?

Graham is closed off, so used to presenting a facade to the world. But in Bellamy he finds his peace. The person he can reveal his true self to. Bellamy has a past she keeps tucked away and she never lets herself get bogged down in emotions. But Graham brings them out in her and her past finally tightens its hold on her. The story is full of great side characters- ones that you'll love (Graham's pack of friends, and Belle's bestie, Evie) and ones that you'll pity (the President and his staffers) and ones that will make you feel disgust (the Blackpool family). There will be some insanely hot moments, and those that will make you swoon. And as always Ms. Wilde never leaves her readers without an HEA.

A good read about a billionaire, Graham, who happens to be brothers with the U.S. President.
