I don't understand the 5 stars, it's like I read a different book. The editing isn't terrible, but it's pretty bad. Events are referenced that were never written about. Pretty disjointed in several areas. I liked the storyline. The characters are very one dimensional, but likeable. If you take it for face value and sophomoric writing, it's a quick steamy read. I didn't dock for the editing, but I did for the sometimes rushed, sometimes random story pieces, where it just didn't flow.

One minute he's in love with her, the next he's sorting through his feelings to figure out if he's in love with her. It seemed more out of order than just sorting through feelings. In one portion she gets a job as a "security". Totally wrong word, should have been secretary. There are several examples of wrong words being used. Quotation marks were used for inner dialogue. Opening quotations were used several times, but never closed. The blurb states he fell in love after hearing the heartbeat. That scene never happened. I got this on KU, so not out anything and there are several bonus stories I won't be reading. This story ends at 15%. Typical length for a quick romance.

When I do not have time to look at goodreads I sometimes just take an Amazon suggestion. Sometimes that works out great and then other times I get stuck reading crap like this. And it is not like I was expecting a lot from a book with this title and blurb. My standards are just not that high.

What was right: The couple are nice. They treat each other well and there is very little drama between them. It was quite short.

What was not right: Lots of telling not showing. Things skip around and we really do not see a lot of them building their relationship. I cared so little I did not even bother to read the epilogue. Missing words and insertion of his ex's names where it did not go. (I think a cut and paste error). The book only takes up 15% of the pages downloaded. There are 6 other stories that follow. There were huge huge gaps between paragraphs along with paragraphs that make no sense broken as they are. So this lead to a choppy reading experience. I assume these things are done to increase the page count without actually adding content of quality.
