



Here is Greenwood, Vol. 1

They escort Kazuya to his new home, the dorm named Ryokurin-ryu--but because that is so difficult to pronounce, they call it by its English translation, Greenwood. And because Kazuya arrived at school late, he is introduced to his new roommate in the last available room, Shun Kisaragi, the cutest girl in the guy's dorm!

Yg sudah pernah kubaca itu Komatta dan Rutta. Breakfast Club pernah kuintip 1 vol, tapi tdk lanjut lagi krn tdk suka dgn gaya gambarnya dan ceritanya juga monoton bgt. Kalo Takumi-kun itu salah satu seri yg populer bgt, tapi belum niat baca krn dari dulu aku kurang sreg dgn gaya gambarnya mangaka si Takumi-kun itu, sudah pernah baca shoujo manga dari mangaka Takumi-kun itu soalnya.

So, menurutku sih yg terbaik dari semuanya itu adalah Komatta, yg sesungguhnya tidak terlalu shounen-ai sekali *sangat disayangkan*. Komatta ini menurutku jauh lebih bagus daripada Greenwood dan jauh lebih panjang : 26 vol!

Tapi, tak seperti Greenwood (yg super boring dan sepertinya mangaka-nya juga cpt keabisan ide cerita), Komatta ini bikin aku tak bisa berhenti membacanya dari vol 1 hingga tamat. Komatta itu ga ngebosenin seperti Greenwood deh intinya, bahkan aku berharap komiknya bisa lanjut terus selamanya, ga berhenti di vol 26! Bayangin saja seberapa bagus isinya sampe bisa bikin aku ngomong gitu, hahaha. Tapi memang semua komik buatan Abe Miyuki-sensei (mangaka Komatta) itu bagus2 semua sih, seperti Hakkenden dan Super Lovers yg masing2 udah dibikin anime-nya juga.

Oh ya, Komatta itu juga komik jadul, dan ga cuma segi plot saja yg lebih bagus dari Greenwood, tapi juga dari segi artwork. Memang artwork-nya Greenwood ini yg pertama kali bikin aku ilfil buat ngelanjutin chapter 2 vol 1 beberapa tahun yg lalu. Tapi ya seperti biasa, lama2 juga bakal terbiasa kok.

Fantasinya itu ya seperti alternate universe gitu lah, dgn judul2 seperti Devilwood (si hero dari Greenwood menumpas devil) sampe jilid 2!, Cherrywood (versi cewe dari semua penghuni Greenwood, ceritanya si hero masuk ke dimensi lain yg berkebalikan dgn dimensi ini -____-), ada versi cinderella juga, lalu ada lagi acara jalan2 bareng teman yg ketemu hantu-hantu cewek, kucing pemakan mimpi, alien yg punya temuan kloning, dll. Sepertinya mangaka suka dgn tema hantu. Vol 1 ini juga sudah ada hantu yg muncul di side story, pas pula bacanya tengah malam gitu, bikin merinding bgt.

Aku ga tau apakah waktu aku lagi mood baca fantasi itu bakal lebih appreciate model cerita yg banyak side story dan versi AU gitu di dlm Greenwood. Yg pasti sih, Greenwood tdk sesuai harapanku. Aku berharap kualitas plotnya bakal setara Komatta atau jauh lebih bagus, tapi ternyata tidak.
