Gabe and Josh get a new bird in this book Sassy which is laugh out loud funny reading how the two birds squawk naughty words at each other.

"I think we should call this place home," I said out loud. Homes were more than just shelter; they were the walls that housed your dreams, kept you safe, and the place you slept beside the person you loved. It was a word that encompassed so many things. "Home, it is," Gabe agreed.

Their neighbour Emory is back in this book and continues to have his 'visions'. One particular vision turns out to be very troubling for Gabe and Josh and causes them to decide whether to let it over shadow their big day or live in the moment and carry on.
