Oh my! The wait is finally over! Mates is the continuation of Viola Rivard's amazing Running With The Alphas Serial and it was well worth the wait! I love it! This is NOT a standalone story. This is a serial with multiple installments so if you haven't read Books One through Seven, Stop Here! The Books need to be read in the order of their release. The story is exciting, original, fast-paced, compelling, gripping, addictive, humorous, romantic, sweet, heartwarming and a ton of fun. The dialog is smart, well written and flows smoothly. The characters are fascinating, captivating, quirky, engaging, endearing, sexy and at times, laugh out loud funny. Lark, Holly and Glenn are downright hysterical. I can't decide if I should call them the three idiots, the three amigos or the three stooges. Rivard skillfully combines these elements to create a wonderfully written paranormal romance filled with adventure, suspense, humor, family, love, heartbreak, angst and hope. She does an amazing job of connecting the characters from this series with the characters from her Bound to the Alpha series, another great read.

Previously in the series: Taylor has become the mate of both Alder and Hale and things never seem to go smoothly at Halcyon. It seems that Hale and Alder are always at odds and Taylor is always caught in the middle - literally! Whiteriver pack made their move against Hale, Alder and the Halcyon pack. Alder's daughter, Snow, and their pregnant mate Taylor were both kidnapped. Taylor, although severely injured and weak, was rescued but Snow remained a captive until a satisfactory agreement for hunting rights was reached between the two packs. Snow has been safely returned and she finally confesses to Alder that she wants to go live in the human world so he takes her to live with Taylor's former foster mother.

Book Eight: While Alder's away for several months, tensions and jealousy rise between Hale and a very pregnant Taylor who finds herself succumbing to depression. She needs support from Hale but he seems unwilling to give her even a glimmer of love and comfort. Hale finally voices his feelings to Taylor but will she still be able to love him after his surprising dark confession? Taylor is caught in another dangerous situation with only Lark, Holly and Glenn to help her. Oh no! Will Taylor be okay? Will her babies/pups survive? Can the two brother co-alphas, Alder and Hale, somehow manage to put their differences aside? Will the relationship between Taylor and her two alphas survive the strain of pregnancy, absence and jealousy? Oh my goodness gracious! Two sexy wolf alphas who desire the same woman for their mate-check! One beautiful sassy young woman running for her life-check! Danger, drama, jealousy and true feelings are finally revealed-check! Hale has all but abandoned her and Alder has not been home for months taking Snow to live with the humans.
