I received this book from the author for an honest review. It is the second book in the Cupid Chronicles series. From the description I was somewhat skeptical about reading it. I was under the impression it was a paranormal, but to me it was a contemporary romance with a sweet ending.

We are introduced to Michael who turns out to be an angel or more precise a cupid. He is sent to assist individuals who are meant to be together in their relationship to get to a happily ever after. This assignment Michael is to have an apprentice, Ariel, whom he is to instruct on what the duties of a cupid involves. What appears as a straight forward assignment takes on many different struggles for those involved.

Braelyn is a beautiful, single mother who teaches special education at school and volunteers at a local nursing home. She and her son, Tristan, move to Texas for a fresh start, but things are not going well for Tristan as she had hoped for. Braelyn feels that most of his problems are a result of his father signing over all his parental rights just before they moved. Maybe if he had a male role model in his life it would help, so she signs him up to be apart of the Big Brother's program thru school. Needless to say Tristan wasn't overjoyed, but after meeting Michael he decides it might be cool to have someone to hang out with.

As with all old houses problems will arise and they do. Michael offers to oversee some repairs which turn out to be a little more difficult than he expects. He turns to his friend and coworker Noble Blackfeather for assistance. Noble just happens to be Braelyn's next door neighbor and they had met previously. Noble reluctantly agrees, not because he doesn't want to help, but because there is too much chemistry between them. He doesn't do relationships and she was a "forever after" type girl. The more time they spend together the greater the attraction on both sides.

Each fighting the attraction, the more complicated Michael's job became and then throw in Tristan and his objections. Michael feels he may be unable to complete this assignment.

I loved this book. Shauna Allen brings us a sweet romance. She brings us well developed characters with flaws that show true family and relationship issues. The plot flows effortlessly. I would recommend it to anyone.

*The Halo Effect* is a nice continuation of *The Cupid Chronicles*. If I'm honest I didn't like it as much as the first, but I still liked it. Braelyn is a forward woman who knows what she wants and isn't afraid to go after it without coming across as easy. I liked that about her. I also liked her relationship with her son. She was protective, without smothering him and he was polite despite being 14 and in the midst of an emotional upheaval. Noble was, well noble. I felt really sorry for him and was so glad to see him finally opening himself up. I would have liked to get to know him a little more though. You learn his history in this book, but except for lusting over his neighbour you hear very little of his internal dialogue (which would be important since he isn't much of a conversationalist). I was also little disappointed that Michael wasn't as much of a character. This book is much more a romance with a little help from above as opposed to the story of how Michael goes about his Love Duty mission (as in book one). It was still a really sweet romance though.

Like the first book I felt that the author built up the emotional hurdles to be overcome and then let them fall almost miraculously. I was often not explicitly aware of where characters change of hearts came from. It was emotionally satisfying that they did change, but I would have liked a little bit more understanding of how or why instead of just when.

My only two real complaints are that it was a little predictable (and questionably realistic) and the preachiness was amped up compared to book one. In *Inked by an Angel* the religious characters spouted off about God a bit. Ok, makes sense that's part of their character after all. In this one the narrator had a much more religious bent going on and as a result the whole thing felt much more Christian to me. I don't mind religion in my fiction, but since I'm not in the market for a new religion I don't generally enjoy mini sermons. Luckily, though more apparent, it wasn't overpowering. I look forward to Eli's story whenever book three finally comes out.

Truly a joy to read, *The Halo Effect* broke my heart and put the pieces together again. When Braelyn and Noble meet, it doesn't seem likely that they will save one another, as well as Braelyn's son Tristan, from their broken pasts. But with a little intervention from a couple of angels, plenty of natural chemistry, and a bit of faith, this couple just may have a chance at a trust, family, love, and freedom from their pasts.

Smooth writing, clever, natural dialogue, wonderfully layered and relatable characters, burning sexual chemistry, the exact right amount of darkness and angst balanced with humor, and a truly wonderful story all come together in this book. I was so excited when I found out about a second book in *The Cupid Chronicles* and even more eager to read it when I found out Noble was getting his own book.
