For people considering how to best make some needed or extra money, Crystal Paine has put together a practical how-to guide for finding what can work best for you.

I received an advanced copy of Money Making Mom by joining the book's launch team. I was impressed right away by the review quotes she had received and put on the jacket cover and at the front of the book. The book earned high praise from Dave Ramsey, Michael Hyatt and a vice president of Chick-Fil-A. The book is broken down into ten easy-to-read chapters full of tips and testimonies from people who have experiences and successes with working for themselves. I appreciated that Crystal put focus on finding the reason you want to make more money instead of just making money to make money or have more things. She also focuses on finding what works for you – your passions, your talent, your situation, your time, your determination. This book is not a cookie-cutter solution, it is a guide to finding a customized solution. Crystal run the blog MoneyMakingMom.com and is quite successful at it. However, she didn't start of with a brilliant idea, she worked through many and faced battles along the way. She shares how she started a custom bridal gear company that focused on modest apparel and how it failed. She shares how she fought a big company who tried to use MoneyMakingMomS.com to promote another savings blog. She goes through how she has tweaked her business along the way as things worked, didn't work or new ideas came along. The book also focuses on evaluating what could get in the way of your success and how to use your talent to help others. Many money saving books concentrate on just making money for yourself or your family. Crystal encourages people who find success to be generous as well, including many ideas on how to do that. I would highly recommend this book to any woman who is wanting to make some more money by working from home or starting her own business. Reading this before starting out will give women a chance to evaluate what could really work for them. The only downside is that there isn't a workbook, so you'll want to keep a notebook and pen on hand for taking notes, jotting down ideas and making your own money making plan.

Don't get me wrong—I love big picture theoretical thinking about major issues like women in the workforce. I avidly read books like Lean In, Torn, Life's Work, Overwhelmed, I Know How She Does It, and all of the articles and discussions I come across related to the work/life/parenting identity issue. I'm a product of the ivory/ivied tower, and I identify with the frameworks in most of the work/life balance literature. However, I'm also a mom in my 30s who has made some unconventional career choices, and in that sense, I often feel a bit outside the target audience for working mom books.

That's where Crystal Paine's latest book, Money-Making Mom: How Every Woman Can Earn More and Make a Difference, really shines. Crystal draws on her own experience making money online (which, while flexible, is not realistic for everyone) and then more broadly from women in different situations and circumstances to show how every woman—not just those with Ivy League degrees, advanced certifications, or killer entrepreneurial acumen—can provide for her family and have an impact in her sphere of influence.

While overall I think it's important to read both the theoretical and practical parts of this discussion, I think the practicality of Money-Making Mom may make it more worth your time if you're in a crunch or really in need of practical steps to take from right where you are in life to better your financial situation.
