When you imagine two people finding love I'm pretty sure you don't imagine that happening during the middle of a satanic ritual, but this is exactly what happens in Split.

Asty is lost and reeling from the loss of the two people closest to her. In an attempt to restore the balance to her family that death has thrown off kilter, she sets in motion a ritual to become pregnant by a demon. The person who shows up however, is her father's live-in hostage, Hunter. Asty is ready to forget the hot interaction since her objective has been reached but Hunter is utterly possessed by the lust and curiosity he feels towards this strange girl he found in an abandoned church. Asty plans on killing herself in nine months, so what happens when this cocky biker manages to force himself into her life?

In true K.A. Merikan style, Miss Merikan does not shy away from the uncomfortable details of the subjects

they explore in their stories. This is a truly original book with it's strange plot and twisted characters and while you may not always relate to them, it will make you wish your friends weren't quite as normal. Asty had me enthralled with her originality, she was a strong character but at the same time she was so sad and lost that my heart just bled for her. Hunter was one smooth motherfucker and completely perfect for Asty. He flirted ruthlessly with his filthy words and fearless ways, he was so very sweet to her at times but he also called her on her bullshit at every turn.

There are many twists in this story and it develops at a fantastic pace. And that describes exactly the feeling I get when I start to read these two amazing authors. You think you know from the blurb, then you start to read it, then you always get blown away! I must admit, my curiosity got the best of me. Being an avid MC Romance fan, I couldn't resist checking out Split. While the occult is not something I'm interested in personally, I wanted to see how it would play out in a biker book. I have to confess, it creeped me out. I found myself reading with only one eye open, in case I had to close it quickly - lol!

The story starts out in the middle of a ritual, so there's no gradual work up, I was just thrown into a WTF? situation and kept trying to figure out what was going on. I was repulsed and interested at the same time as I realized what Asty was attempting to accomplish. I just kept shaking my head and turning the page, hoping she would get a wake-up-call and change her course.

The story is told in third-person with alternating POV. I prefer first person because it seems to help me connect to the characters better. I struggled doing that because I was mentally resisting the events taking place so it made it more difficult for me to get attached to the characters. However; I was hoping for Hunter & Asty to overcome the obstacles preventing them from being together. I was concerned for their safety in the middle of the unrest between the two clubs. I was worried about them as I saw evil directed at them and I wanted to warn them it was coming.

I read this book as a standalone. However; one of my favorite characters was Lucky. It made me curious to go back and read it story. His flamboyance and sense of humor attracted me and made me want to take a peek at his relationship with Tooth. Their banter was amusing and I bet their love was hard won.

To say that their relationship started off a little backward is an understatement. First comes love, then comes marriage....you know the story, but that wasn't the case here. After they first meet, Hunter is definitely drawn to Asty....but the feelings aren't necessarily mutual in the beginning.

They are both dealing with quite a bit in their personal lives. Hunter is in a new MC and he isn't really getting along with his cousin.
