However, the Outlaw MC in this series ARE criminals who DO engage in criminal activity by bringing guns illegally into a country that is relatively gun-free compared to other countries (like the U.S.), so I don't actually feel sorry for the characters in this book because they pretty much all deserve to go to prison (the guys in the MC) for murder or arms trafficking.

However, they don't deserve to go to prison just for wearing their patches or riding their bikes in groups.

Not that I don't enjoy reading about MC romance like every other reader of the genre, but I can't feel sorry for bikers who ARE criminals.

This was more a novella than a novel in length and plot, being that there wasn't much of a plot and some of it was flashbacks to previous books. It was mostly boring because though I like Cole, I don't love the actual main couple of the series and don't have a real interest in them.

The author should write a book with a Cole type of character who does all his crazy badass (or badarse) assassinations and ninja stealth moves like in book 2. That's way more interesting.
