This is book 7 of the Jack Nightingale series, I have not read any others.

There is an under story running through this, one involving a couple of the characters here, and I missed all that for not reading the other books. BUT while some of the undertones of the book escaped me, I really did

enjoy this!

The demons are calling on children who are playing a game called Charlie Charlie (no idea if this is a real game, but sounds dangerous!) and who are then upgrading to Ouija boards. THESE are deadly, and cost 6 teenagers their lives, along with a many others who the demons have "fun" with.

Its quite graphic in its violence, and we do get some of the demons as well as Jack and ya'll know how much I love that!

My other point, besides the under story running from other books, was how it ended. It just did. Like, stopped. Dead. Weird, I thought.

Still, a good read, a different to the usual paranormal stuff and I will look to read other books by Leather at a later date.
