The story follows Ryan Madewell (love the name btw!) and his quest to break away from becoming the heir to his Father's publishing empire and to pursue his dream of becoming a writer. On a trip to The Met to search for inspiration for his next article, he meets Allee Adair, a tour guide at the museum. Everything about Allee is so different from his current, soon to be ex-girlfriend, Charlotte. Allee is rough around the edges, whereas Charlotte is refined and comes from old money in New York City. Allee is not afraid to be herself and tell it like it is, whereas Charlotte is used to being catered to and looking down upon those who are not from within her inner-circle.

Allee guides Ryan to a little known Picasso painting and inspires him to write his article from his heart. Ryan begins to admire Allee's attitude and quickly falls for her and the obvious differences from Charlotte.
