Her step-father is a closed book and her first boyfriend beat the crap out of her, verbally abused her and raped her. She has no self-worth and no self-esteem. She hates herself and thinks that she deserves all of the bad things that happened to her.

I sob harder and harder with the feeling of worthlessness. I have nothing, and no one loves me. I'm falling deeper and deeper into a hole of blackness...

Jed is tired of the dating scene and is ready to find a good woman to settle down with. When he sees Anna the first thing he thinks is that she is beautiful. So when his uncle tells him that she is the girl that he wants to introduce the two of them, Jed is excited to meet her. But when he does she is very shy and doesn't go for his normal pick-up tactics, he is not sure how to approach her. When fate steps in and she needs a ride home from work, he is more than happy to help her out.

Looking to escape the pain that being rejected by all of the men in her life, Anna turns to self harm as a means to dull the pain. When the reality of her life and what she is doing to herself becomes clear, Anna sets out on a path of repair her broken heart.
