After the first 100 pages of this book, I had a rant about using unnecessary business jargon without definition going on in my head, but I have to admit to having been somewhat hopeful for these characters. After the second 100 pages, I found it difficult to remember what my problem with the book was during the first 100 pages and found myself screaming internally at the characters that they should just *do it* already for god's sake. After the third 100 pages, I was sighing and saying "goddamnit, finally... uh oh, *of course* something must go wrong." Unfortunately for them, the chemistry since the moment they lay eyes on each other is more powerful than either one is prepared to accept and it's enough to bring one awkward situation after another. Add to that the fact that they are must work closely together, despite Lucas reluctance to accept her help, the non-fraternization company policy and a change of arrangements of one business trip to make things a tad more complicated for the pair.

This was my first read by Ms. Michaels and I have to say that I was very impressed. The book is beautifully written, witty from page one and has some of the best deliveries I've ever read before.
