I really like this anthropomorphic adventure series. Mathews has done a good job building her world and her characters, and there's plenty of swashbuckling to go with all the subterfuge and personal dilemmas. Both of the first two books in the series are available for free on Nook, and I really feel that's a serious score; Mathews should be getting money from them, as they are written better than most published novels are these days. This second book wraps up the Mosque Hill tale neatly and provides a tease to entice you to read the next book, and I shall. This is a great series.

One note, which is that while this is often compared to *The Wind in the Willows*, I think that is really not an appropriate comparison. It has much more in common with Brian Jacques' *Redwall*. Except that I liked this immensely, and I have never been able to like *Redwall*. Mathews' series has plenty of violence and death in it, so while parents might feel pirate otters will make a good read for their younger readers, I definitely suggest they read it themselves before approving it for their pre-teens. I would let my kids read it if their comprehension level was high enough and they were mature for their ages; otherwise, I would hesitate to recommend this for a kid younger than 12 (and certainly not younger than 10).
