Having done a few other Beth Moore studies (James is still my favorite), I appreciate some of the changes she has made to the more current workbooks. There isn't much space for answering the questions asked in this workbook. The content was good for the most part. Some of the areas for personal reflection felt very generic and didn't leave me thinking about them long after like I have in previous studies. Overall, I felt like I learned a LOT more about Jesus through the study. So while there wasn't an overwhelming amount of personal application, I learned a lot of background - both to the Jewish faith and the life of Christ. All of that will help me continue to build my faith. I felt like the videos really helped drive the content home and helped give extra information for understanding what was read.
