BURNING DESIRE: Part 3 by Donna Grant marks a great continuation of the story of Dragon King Kiril and Dark Fae Shara. It's the third serialized installment in the third book in her Dark King series featuring the stories of a clan of seriously sexy Scottish dragon shifters.

I LOVE, LOVE, LOVE Dragon King Kiril. He is swoon worthy as heck - an old, very smart alpha male whose Scottish brogue makes me melt. Shara, our Dark Fae heroine, is likable also. She doesn't seem like other nasty Dark Fae. I'm still on the fence as to whether Kiril should trust her though I'm becoming more convinced of her innocence with this installment. It's still not looking good for Rhi who was captured by Balladyn, a Dark Fae now, but previously Rhi's Light Fae role model and friend. He's super creepy now. I'm still holding out hope that our good guys will figure out a way to save her. More characters from the previous books are arriving to join the party: Con, Phelan, Rhys and the Queen of the Light Fae.

Kiril and Shara can no longer deny the passion between them but there's still a huge question of trust. They have a plan of sorts to rescue Rhi, but things aren't going very well...

I'm normally not a fan of serialized books but I just couldn't wait for the full book to be released.

All in all this was a very good read and I highly recommend Donna's books. I'm addicted to her books. She's a must-read author for me!

Book 3 (inclusive of all the serialized installments) could be read as a standalone but the reader's enjoyment would be exponentially enhanced if the prior books had been read previously as there are interconnected characters and a continuing story thread beneath Kiril's and Shara's story. Besides that, all the previous books are fantastic... so why skip them?

Part three out of four of Kiril and Shara Blackwood his Fae lover and destined mate. As the Dark Kings (dragons) continue to fight the Fae and other minions of Ulrik who was stripped of his powers and imprisoned centuries before. He is now free and determined to bring the Dark Kings down and take over the world in his image.

We learn more on Shara and her people. Kiril vacillates over his feelings for Shara and his duties to defeat Ulrik. Although both have histories that cause them to guard their hearts they must now open themselves to the other or they could both loose. The over all story is very interesting and continues to hold my interest, but feel Kiril needs to get his arrogance under control and realize the world does not revolve around him as he has through parts one and two. Thankfully he does see beyond his own nose.

The dragons of course are all Alpha A-types. Gorgeous and compelling, they draw the eyes and desires of

females. Yet when they find their mates they are loyal, faithful and protective. Unfortunately being from the Fae race complicates the path to true love for Kiril and Shara.

With skirmishes all around you are drawn into the conflict and feel for Shara as she realizes her choice between love and family is a painful one. Watch as the two work their way toward each other. BURNING DESIRE Part 3 is another fast paced instalment that moves the story into the hidden Fae realm where Kiril and Phalen begin their search for Rhi. Not only do they encounter what is left of Rhi but Kiril knows that his time is limited as it pertains to Shara's safety. Shara's involvement has been discovered and she too is at risk for a tormented future but has she betrayed Kiril and set the Dragon Kings up for capture? As the Dragon Kings begin their search for Kiril, Kiril finds himself caught in the Fae realm with the possibility of no hope for escape.

Part 3 reveals a little more about the relationship between the King of Dragon Kings Constantine and his fellow Kings. Theirs is a relationship built out of respect but one that begins to question Con's need for revenge against the King of the Silver Dragons.

Reviewing a storyline in serial format is difficult without giving away too many spoilers or sounding repetitive with each instalment. As the storyline builds, each episode reveals a little bit more information as well as the continued growth of the hero and heroine-their relationship and their love. And because each portion, in and of itself, is not a complete storyline it is difficult at times to be selective with the information passed along.

Because BURNING DESIRE continues the Dragon Kings storylines, the series should be read in order. Most of the characters from the previous storylines, and the original series and spinoff play a secondary role throughout. The Dark Kings is a spinoff from Donna's Dark Warrior series which in turn is a spin off from Donna's Dark Sword series- all set in the Highlands of Scotland. Each novella is approximately 70-75 pages in length

Kiril and Shara have started to bond. She tells him where Rhi is being held and offers her help. Kiril has decided to go into Balladyn's fortress and rescue Rhi by himself. He has communicated with Con the Dragon King and his friend Phelam that he will be returning home but plans instead to go to the Fae Realm and try to rescue Rhi. Kiril wants to protect those he cares about and not take a chance of them being harmed if things go wrong. He has carefully planned with Shara how things will go during the rescue. As Kiril waits for the Dark to overrun his home hunting for him he goes into the specially prepared cellar and transforms into his dragon form. All of his wards are in place and only another dragon would see his hiding place.

Shara has to deal with her family and Balladyn before she can implement the plan that Kiril had made. Her brother is on trial for the betrayal of his family and his disgrace at Balladyn's hands. She will not betray Kiril regardless of what happens to her, he is her one love. Everything is going according to plan until Balladyn tells her that she will be with him at his side from now on and will not be returning to her parents. How can she let Kiril know what is happening without Balladyn knowing? Will Kiril believe that she has betrayed him?

Who is feeding the Dark Fae their information? Is there a traitor among the dragons? Will they succeed in destroying Kiril and Shara's chance to be together?
