THE GOOD, THE BAD, AND THE INDIFFERENT

I enjoyed the story and the characters. While this was a Mafia based story, and the references were subtly made about the family and business in general, it was not the basis for the story. Instead, it is more about two people, Lily and Victor and their growing relationship from guardian and protector to disciplinary and eventually to lover.

Lily's father dies leaving her orphaned, with her mother dying during childbirth. She is moved to the Scalia family home where she will be raised alongside Patty Scalia. Lily seems aloof, but it has more to do with a lack of love and affection growing up, her shyness, and uncertainty.

Victor Scalia is head of the family and their businesses, both legal and not so legal. He has always been impressed with Lily from the time she came to live with them. She is quiet, unassuming, and has never given the family any problems, or that was until Mama Scalia and Patty are kidnapped, and against his orders, she carries out the wishes of the kidnappers, and police, placing her life in danger.

The plot will share bits and pieces of Lily's life before becoming part of the Scalia family, and the growing relationship of Victor and Lily. Growing up in the Scalia household, he never once had to discipline Lily, she was always easy going and obedient. After she disobeyed when Mama Scalia and Patty are kidnapped, she will be punished harshly by Victor, which also be the catalyst for the beginning of their romance, and at this point and time, Lily is in her mid-twenties. Once Victor and Lily's relationship changes with him punishing her, he also states his intent to date her. At first, it is casual, and it is after a long and intense punishment when things change sexually between them. The story has several very intense punishments and explicit sex scenes. Can these two find their happily ever after? "Even sinners need love—they need the purity and hope of love, more so than anyone else."
